5	<ul> <li>this is an example of proficient writing</li> <li>CONTENT: The story is engaging, easy to follow, and conveys some form of theme or message.</li> <li>STYLE: Style displays some manipulation of language to achieve a desired effect. The writing has a strong voice and clear sense of audience. Vocabulary and sentence structure are varied and serve the writer's purpose successfully.</li> <li>CONVENTION: any errors do not detract from the reader's understanding</li> </ul>	
4	<ul> <li>this composition is <u>competent</u></li> <li>CONTENT: assertions/storyline is simplistic and straightforward.</li> <li>STYLE: vocabulary and sentence structure are usually appropriate, but lack variety. The structure of the narrative is predictable and relatively mechanical.</li> <li>CONVENTIONS: conventions of language are usually followed, but the reader is aware of errors</li> </ul>	
3	<ul> <li>this paper is <u>barely adequate</u></li> <li>CONTENT: The storyline may be very simple or difficult to follow at times.</li> <li>STYLE: little variety in vocabulary and sentence structure is discernable</li> <li>CONVENTIONS: although the reader may be aware of some purpose, errors impede the fluency of composition</li> </ul>	
2	<ul> <li>this paper is inadequate</li> <li>CONTENT: underdeveloped ideas are simply and/or awkwardly expressed and storyline/ point of the narrative is difficult to follow or identify.</li> <li>STYLE/CONVENTIONS: reflects little knowledge of the conventions of language and very basic vocabulary. Errors are frequent and basic</li> </ul>	
1	<ul> <li>this paper is <u>unacceptable</u></li> <li>CONTENT: does not meet the purpose of the task or may be too brief to address the topic</li> <li>STYLE/CONVENTIONScompromised by its brevity, and its deficiency of composition, content, vocabulary, sentence structure, paragraph structure, voice and conventions of language so as to render its meaning/purpose almost unintelligible</li> </ul>
